Scripture and Song Meditations – PRAYER

Presented here is a collection of Bible verses and hymns to use for personal, small group, or congregational worship. Bible verses are paired with hymns to create a smooth and cohesive flow of the spoken Word with music (either instrumental or singing). The format is very similar to the familiar "Lessons and Carols" format commonly use at Christmas time. No sheet music is provided since the music follows standard hymnal arrangements found on hymnary.org.

"Prayer" is the theme for this set of "Scripture and Song Meditations." Below is the outline of Bible verses and hymns included in this devotional guide and corresponds to the YouTube video. Only the first verse of each song is included forming a presentation just over 20 minutes in length. Customizing the outline below to better meet your personal or church preferences could include the following modifications:

- include more verses for some of the songs for added program length
- read from a different Bible version that is more familiar or more contemporary
- have various instrumental and vocal musicians present each song
- have a variety of people of all ages take turns reading the Scriptures

All Scripture readings are taken from "The World English Bible (WEB)" The WEB is a Public Domain (no copyright) Modern English translation of the Holy Bible

OPENING SONG: Whisper a Prayer

Whisper a prayer in the morning, Whisper a prayer at noon, Whisper a prayer in the evening, To keep your heart in tune.

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 51:1-3, 9-13

Have mercy on me, God, according to your loving kindness.

According to the multitude of your tender mercies,

blot out my transgressions.

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity. Cleanse me from my sin.

For I know my transgressions. My sin is constantly before me.

Purify me with hyssop, and I will be clean.

Wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all of my iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a right spirit within me.

Don't throw me from your presence,

and don't take your Holy Spirit from me.

Restore to me the joy of your salvation. Uphold me with a willing spirit.

Then I will teach transgressors your ways. Sinners will be converted to you.

SONG: Search Me, O Lord

Search me, O God, and know my heart today;

Try me, O Savior, know my thoughts, I pray.

See if there be some wicked way in me;

Cleanse me from every sin and set me free.

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 6:5-13

When you pray, you shall not be as the hypocrites, for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men. Most certainly, I tell you, they have received their reward. But you, when you pray, enter into your inner room, and having shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. In praying, don't use vain repetitions as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard for their much speaking. Therefore don't be like them, for your Father knows what things you need before you ask him. Pray like this:

Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy.

Let your Kingdom come.

Let your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

Forgive us our debts, as we also forgive our debtors.

Bring us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

For yours is the Kingdom, the power, and the glory forever. Amen.

SONG: Sweet Hour of Prayer

Sweet hour of prayer, sweet hour of prayer, That calls me from a world of care And bids me at my Father's throne Make all my wants and wishes known! In seasons of distress and grief My soul has often found relief, And oft escaped the tempter's snare By thy return, sweet hour of prayer.

SCRIPTURE: James 1:5-8

But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

But let him ask in faith, without any doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, driven by the wind and tossed.

For that man shouldn't think that he will receive anything from the Lord. He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

SCRIPTURE: Hebrews 4:16

Let's therefore draw near with boldness to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace for help in time of need.

SONG: Father, Lead Me Day by Day

Father, lead me day by day Ever in thine own sweet way; Teach me to be pure and true, Show me what I ought to do.

SCRIPTURE: 2 Chronicles 7:14

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 26:41

Watch and pray, that you don't enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

SCRIPTURE: Philippians 4:6-7

In nothing be anxious, but in everything, by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus.

SONG: Did You Think to Pray?

When you left your room this morning, did you think to pray? In the name of Christ our Savior, did you seek His loving favor, As a shield today?

Oh, how praying rests the weary!
Prayer will change the night to day;
So in sorrow and in gladness, Don't forget to pray.

SCRIPTURE: Jeremiah 29:11-14

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you," says Yahweh, "thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you hope and a future. You shall call on me, and you shall go and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You shall seek me, and find me, when you search for me with all your heart. I will be found by you," says Yahweh.

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 5:1-3

Give ear to my words, Yahweh. Consider my meditation.

Listen to the voice of my cry, my King and my God; for I pray to you.

Yahweh, in the morning you will hear my voice.

In the morning I will lay my requests before you, and will watch expectantly.

SONG: In the Garden

SCRIPTURE: Luke 11:9

But the Spirit himself makes intercession for us with groanings which can't be uttered.

SONG: I Must Tell Jesus

SCRIPTURE: 1 John 5:14-15

SCRIPTURE: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Always rejoice. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus toward you **SCRIPTURE:** Mark 11:24

Therefore I tell you, all things whatever you pray and ask for, believe that you have received them, and you shall have them.

SONG: Tell It to Jesus

Are you weary, are you heavy hearted?

O bless me now, my Savior, I come to thee.

SCRIPTURE: Jeremiah 33:3

Call to me, and I will answer you,

you will ask whatever you desire, and it will be done for you.

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 145:18

Yahweh is near to all those who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.

CLOSING SONG: Whisper a Prayer

God answers prayer in the morning,

God answers prayer at noon,

God answers prayer in the evening,

So keep your heart in tune.
